FROM THE NGFNL PRESIDENT



Hello everyone and welcome to our Qualifying and Elimination finals.

Let me start by saying that now round 18 is behind us I think every club, every administrator, every volunteer, member and supporter should be congratulated for masterminding and pulling together to deliver an uninterrupted Home and Away series. I thank you and salute you all.

To all league sponsors and the many hundreds of club sponsors I equally say thank you for putting your money into our community-based clubs. An interesting point is that most sponsors have not only dug deep in 2022 but many have done likewise in 2020 and 2021 when things were really tough for the majority of businesses to support our clubs in difficult times. The least any of us can do is try and support these businesses when you have a need or at a minimum at least give them a chance to quote for your business. It is fair to say there were a few hiccups and a few incidents along the way in the 2022 home and away season but given what we experienced in 2020 and 2021 there is no doubt in my mind that when it is all said and done "good was better than perfect". Notwithstanding this, we must cross each bridge as come to them and today here are at Sale City on Saturday and Churchill on Sunday to kick off the 2022 finals campaign.

However, before I get into talking about this week's matches lets firstly review last week's results where the Saints finished the year with a solid performance but could not hold off the Dogs who recorded another well-deserved win. In the Qualifying final Saturday Churchill will play TTU at Stephenson Park. The Cougars have had a solid season and have shared top of the ladder billing with YYN for a number of weeks. This alone says they are an outfit to be weary off this time of year, but it could equally be argued they are still reeling from their round 16 clash where the Bombers went to Gaskin Park and departed victorious.

In my experience the Churchill FNC thrives on big challenges and a fully fit TTU will be exactly that today. The Cougars are not afraid to be creative and back their ability to win more contests than they lose and this mindset is very handy when you find yourself in a "there is no tomorrow" environment. The Cougars have many solid aspects to their game all over the ground and of recent times have found a way for multiple options up forward to get a score on the board.

Regardless of any venue conditions I think this should be a cracking game and I will be watching with interest to see how some tactics from both clubs unfold.

I hear on the grape vine the Cougars will get a few back from injury and this can only help their cause and campaign. In a close one I think the Cougars will get the job done, but according to some of the old TTU stalwarts who gather around the bar, the League President would know his left foot from his right and therefore what would I really know! I guess come 5pm Saturday we will know the answer to that question and all will be revealed. One of use will be drinking a free refreshment and there is nothing better than a free refreshment!!

On Sunday we head to Gaskin Park Churchill for our Elimination final between our league's southern rivals the Yarram Dees and Woodside Wildcats in what should be another cracking game and I am absolutely sure neither club will hold anything back in the pursuit of victory.

I must admit I have not seen a lot of either team this year but both clubs have proven they can compete at this level, and both will enjoy the challenge of yet another local derby on neutral territory. The Dees have significant finals experience and boast some big-time finals players. In short, they know what to do but do they the cattle to get the job done like yesteryear? The Cats were fantastic in 2021 and have carried most of that form over into 2022. Injury has not been kind to the Cats and at times have had some tough conditions to endure and maybe they are just hitting form at the right time of year.

The Churchill venue has the best drainage of any NGFNL Venue and from that perspective the ground should recover reasonably well after a wet week. I am hoping the ground is conducive of a fast-paced game. It is a bit tricky to try and select a winner here as I do not think there is much between these 2 teams but which ever club gets an upper hand in the mid field to provide their forwards a few extra opportunities I think will get the chocolates.

I suspect the Cats have a lot more to play for and whilst they did not get the chocolates in round 18 their form was pretty good. However, the Dees will be coming off a bye in round 18 and I am sure some of those older bodies would have appreciated the break. In my eyes this game is an each way bet but to create some good theatre, maybe the Cats by a point!

Not much has communicated about our Netball in 2022 as were unable to find a Netball scribe for 2022 and Netball Nancy is now in a nursing home. However, this element of our league is as vibrant and thrilling as it has ever been. I encourage everyone to get alone and have a look I am confident you will not be disappointed.






