FROM THE NGFNL PRESIDENT

Of course, we all know winter is coming and unfortunately that means some cooler weather around the corner and perhaps the odd rainy day and harsh wintery conditions. Thank goodness that does not last for ever and I will always keep one eye on the horizon for spring to arrive and smell of finals in the air.

In last week's travels I did not venture too far from home as I had a commitment to Brentcorp until 11 pm and thereafter I headed to catch up with all at TTU who were hosting the Rosedale Blues. Again the venue was in great shape and the newly surfaced Netball courts got a huge tick of approval from all and sundry despite any perceived teething issues in round 2. I then headed to the hanger of the Jets as they were playing a twilight game against the Roo's. More on that later.

Every now and then I hear in the marketplace the comments about divisional football. In my time I think I have AFL Vic commission 4 Football reviews within Gippsland and to be honest not much that is truly positive has come from that investment and discussion. Gippsland is a very diverse area, one size does not fit all and there are many localised issues which are not generic in all parts of Gippsland and thus why it has been difficult to rollout the perfect model.

In that regard I have some strong views on what should happen around this part of the world. I am not sure this is the right medium to be tabling in detail those thoughts but what I will say is this.

We are all responsible for getting the investment and structures in junior sport better than what they are now. This is not a derogatory statement to those who occupy any position in junior sport but a comment to say we all need to offer help, guidance and financial support if needed to grow this aspect of the game of football. As I have said many times, this is the pond we all feed from and therefore we all have a responsibility to nourish and develop this part of collective futures.

Secondly it is tough space for clubs to consistently struggle for on field success and therefore it seems to make sense that water should be allowed to find its own level but current day structures do not allow for this to happen. On the surface this sounds easy but there are many deeper issues to negotiate and mitigate should that ever happen. That being said, the Administrators I know in AFL Vic are good people who have genuine desires to make our game better and I am hopeful that in the fullness of time, all options will be at least explored.

FROM THE NGFNL PRESIDENT

Last week's round 4 revealed some comprehensive results. The Bombers started well and never took the foot of the gas running out significant winners against the Blues. WHAT'S ON



One of the biggest funding programs benefiting grassroots footy in Victoria is back in 2023, with community clubs given the opportunity to share in \$600,000 of investment through the Transport Accident Commission's (TAC) Club Rewards Program.

The program is a key feature of the TAC's 32-year partnership with AFL Victoria and rewards football clubs in metropolitan and country regions with up to \$10,000 for their efforts to promote road safety in

their clubs and local communities. 150 clubs were recipients of funding through the program last year. Launched at the Rumbalara Football Netball Club in Shepparton, the program has provided more than \$2.3 million over the past four years to hundreds of Victorian football and netball clubs, which has helped with a range of initiatives, including facility improvements, the purchase of new equipment, training for members and offering safe transport from club events.

Head of AFL Victoria, Ben Kavenagh, said: "AFL Victoria and the TAC have been proud partners for 32 years now, and this investment is another tremendous show of support for community football by the TAC."

"There have been 107 lives lost on Victoria's roads this year already, and it's an unfortunate reality that most grassroots football and netball clubs across the state have been affected by road trauma in some way.

"Our footballers can cover hundreds of kilometres on the roads every year as they travel to and from training and games, so road safety is something that we all need to be thinking about. The TAC Club Rewards Program is a great way for clubs to encourage these important conversations to keep each other safe."

Minister for Roads and Road Safety Melissa Horne said: "Victoria's grassroots football and netball clubs have strong community connections and a culture of looking out for their teammates.

"This partnership allows us to reward clubs that proactively promote road safety throughout the season, injecting much-needed support for club initiatives, while they help to keep our roads safe."

TAC's Head of Road Safety Samantha Cockfield: "Too many people have died on our roads this year, and we know that distracted driving is a key and prevalent issue among young to middle-aged drivers, thousands of whom spend many hours at local sporting clubs every week.

"Victoria's football and netball clubs are often at the heart of their communities and prioritising road safety within local clubs could be the reason someone gets home safely, instead of a tragic alternative."

SELECTION CRITERIA

The nominee must demonstrate a combination of at least three (3) of the following criteria.

- Superior of performance that indicates their desire to achieve & play at the highest level within the NGFNL in future years.
- Passion & dedication to their sport & club both on the field/court & off.
(Examples must be provided via the nomination form)
- Initiative both off & on the field/court.
(Examples must be provided via the nomination form)
- Nomination must be under the age of 21 as at the commencement of round one in that year.
- Monthly winners can be nominated each month unless selected as a monthly winner.
- Nominations must be placed by the 7th day of each month.
- A player who is suspended during the current season will not be eligible to win the award.
- Anyone can nominate a player, via your club executive and must be endorsed accordingly.

The elected NGFNL panel will have the final say on awarding the monthly recipient & overall winner for the year.

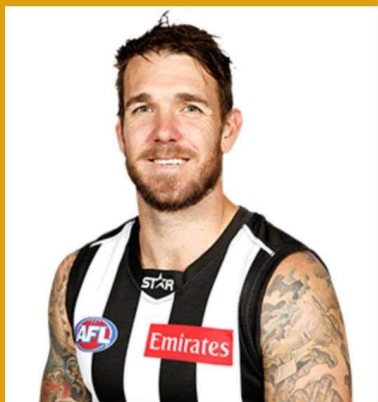
