NGFNL BOARD REPORT



Hello everyone and welcome to round sixteen (16) of our 2023 season.

I know I keep saying this, but I cannot believe we are only 3 weeks away from our finals series and despite all the planning and discussions we have had around the Board table I am feeling a little overwhelmed and unprepared. We have our finals Football and netballs in the cupboard, new gear to drive the 'be north gippy' brand for our Netball Umpires on our Grand Final showpiece day, the Premiership Flags have arrived in readiness, ground selections and catering locked in for finals, Vic Pol discussions completed, trophies ordered, Vote count night well underway, new grand final dais taking shape, premiership medals ordered, finals gate keepers via local CFA brigades assisting done, additional toilets and grand stands for Grand Final done, floats and electronic payments systems okay, Grand Final Dinner venue locked in, various MC's and sound systems, security and passes checked off and league trailer serviced and all items verified.

Let's talk a little bit of Football. I mentioned last week the Roo's continuing to show growth and promise and that journey gained additional momentum last week when the Roo's knocked off last year's Premiers the Jets. Boy oh boy if Damien Birss had a smile on his face the week before against the Cougars, I can only imagine it was an open cheque book for Mrs Birss to go shopping this week. But in all seriousness, I can see the Roo's challenging for a 3rd place finish come the end of the home and away series and that would be an exciting story within the NGFNL. The Doggies have struggled when injury occurs and from that perspective the bye last week will have helped, and I am sure they will be up for the challenge this week. The latest round of AFL Victoria's major funding program benefiting community football clubs, the Strategic Community Investment Fund (SCIF), is closing after a successful program in 2023 that has seen funds directed to many exciting projects. This year, more than \$1.8 million worth of funding has been approved and will go towards financially supporting local clubs, to go with nearly \$2.5 million in funding approved from the previous two years. The 2023 SCIF program closes on July 25. Here are some examples of projects that will benefit from SCIF funding allocated in 2023:

Newbridge Football Netball Club, Loddon Valley Football Netball League

The club's facilities suffered significant flood damage in the October 2022. Funding awarded will go towards covering costs related to improving the ground surface, as well as netting behind the goals, line marking equipment, point-of-sale systems and technology equipment.

Paynesville Football Netball Club, East Gippsland Football Netball League

The club successfully applied for funding to support staging a game during NAIDOC week to celebrate

and support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander participants and members of their community. Funds were directed towards purchasing Indigenous-themed jumpers to be worn on the day, which was part of a number of activities the club held. Head of AFL Victoria, Ben Kavenagh, said that SCIF funding assists in a wide range of endeavours that enhance participation and sustainability for players, volunteers and the clubs they are part of.

"Community football is the heartbeat of so many Victorian towns and communities, playing a critically important role in not only providing participation opportunities but delivering a range of benefits across social, health, community and economic outcomes.

"The AFL understands the challenges faced by football clubs across Australia, especially with changing demographics in many areas and community expectations. Helping strategically strengthen, sustain and grow community football is vital, and the AFL will continue to invest in important initiatives to help grow the game and the communities involved."

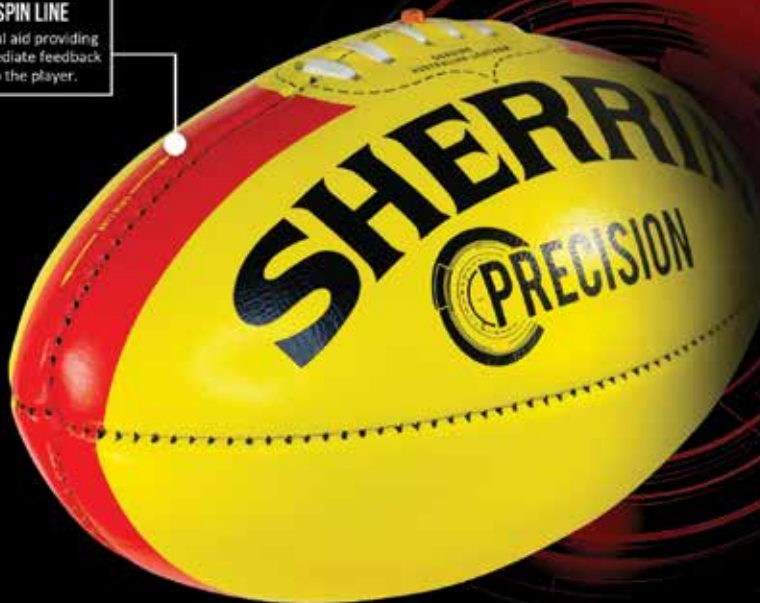
