NGFNL BOARD REPORT



Hello everyone and welcome to round seventeen (17) of our 2023 season.

Last week I headed to the home of the Bombers to watch a couple of inform teams do battle. I donned the green gear to umpire the seconds and with my ageing aching knees and few other sore spots I don't think I was at my best game (Ando will agree) & perhaps it is time to retire the whistle. Yep, even my umpire shirt has shrunk, hot water and cold beer will do that!! I can even hear a few cheers should that be the case but nor do I feel offended, you know when it is time to move on.

My best guess is I must have been close to playing 500 senior games, been involved in multiple grand final days, chalked up a few premierships here and there, I am probably a 20 odd games short of 300 umpired which would be a nice milestone to hit, but collectively I guess that's a reasonable journey on the field of battle for someone who was only average at best. Sometimes you must be happy with your lot in life, and I can live with that. Maybe there is a year or two left in me to implement a few structural things around the NGFNL before I sign off entirely but be assured that day is fast approaching, I am 100% sure of that!!

We are rapidly headed toward the business end of the season and for some this cannot come quick enough and for others it is full of excitement and anticipation. But first things first we must get the last few rounds behind us before we allow ourselves to drift into finals mode. It's an old saying but a lot can happen between one week of Football and Netball to the next and from where I sit this rings true most weekends.

There are not too many weeks when there is not some sort of issue which has caused angst or grievance which requires some discussion or directional guidance. Most weeks I have a discussion with AFL Gippsland or AFL Vic and every week during a normal home and away season the leagues administration is reviewing and recording a significant amount of information

gathered during each week's rounds. For example, ground conditions, player behaviour via code of conduct reporting across 9 grades in 5 matches or 90 pieces of info per week to digest, review umpire votes in both Football and Netball to ensure accuracy and record that info for end of season vote counts, bi-law application, breaches or clarification sought, player qualification and registration issues, SUA reports or concerns, Overage permit reviews and then our general board business which from time to time presents us with issues from left field just to make us all think twice.

Last week I advised we would have Mr Gary Ablett jnr as our guest speaker for our Grand Final Dinner and this week I can confirm our Grand Final Breakfast speaker will be Collingwood identity and Legend Mr Tony Shaw. For anyone who has listened to Tony on various media shows he is never short of an opinion, and I have no doubt he will entertain those who are in attendance at this years Grand Final Breakfast. Tickets will be available shortly but if interested in getting a table together let your club or myself know and I will lock this into the schedule of the day.

Let's take a moment to reflect on last week's senior matches.

The Bombers jumped out of the gate early with and 8 goal to one first quarter against the young Roo's which set the scene for the balance of the day. Whilst I did not expect this blowout, nor does it surprise me as the Bombers have rightfully earned top dog status all season. The young Roo's will learn from this and quickly put this match behind them. The Blues were expected got the points over the Tigers but again I am encouraged by the Tigers hitting the score board with regularity. The Dees accounted for the Saints keeping their finals chances alive, The Cats who have been solid all year departed the Kennel with another 4 points in the Bank and the Jets at home did their confidence no harm with a big win over the Pies who had no answer to the Jets talented list.

- The Roo's will be back on home soil this week at the Gordon st Reserve with perhaps their wings clipped a little bit from last week's encounter. My view is perhaps not so drastic, the Bombers are a quality team, no one questions that point. Coach Brown will know that with a young team their will always be lessons to learnt, weeks when they inspire and weeks when nothing seems to go right. This week the Roo's will be keen to get back on the winners list and they will be hungry to keep one eye on third spot of the NGFNL ladder. They come up against what I think is an improving Tiger unit who are also a very young team. It is hard for me to see the Roo's letting this game slip, nor winning well and I am sure they will bank another 4 points, but I am more interested in seeing if the Tigers improvement can be sustained and whether they can keep hitting the scoreboard against another top 5 team. I guess at 5pm I will now the answer to that question.

- The Blues host the Saint's and this should be another entertaining match. The Blues have had a season without the magic of luck however I think they have achieved a pass mark for the season and I think most would agree they have set themselves up for further improvement in 2024 by getting more games into a core young group, whilst notching a few wins along the way. I am thinking the Jets get the points, and get one back from the Cougars recent dominance but I say that without knowing either teams' in's and out's. I hope it is a ripping game.

AllPlay Footy now provides more than 360 free and purpose-built and strengths-based tools, resources and strategies for coaches, coordinators and families to support the inclusion of young people with disability in community football.

AllPlay Footy can be accessed via the AFL's play.afl and coach.afl websites. Resources have been developed with people with lived experience of disability and consultants from national sporting organisations for people with disability, psychologists and researchers.

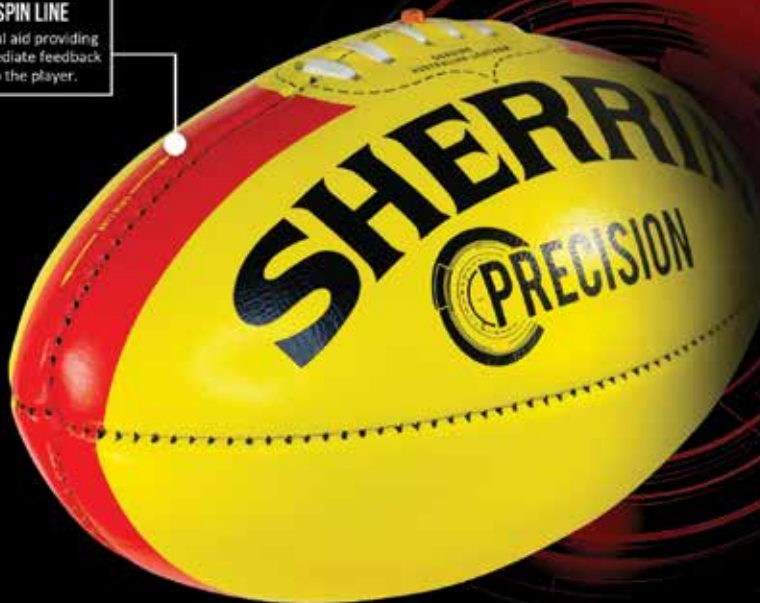
